Things to bring:

- Remaining CYIA Costs
- Remaining CYIA Paperwork
- Water bottle
- Your own BIBLE (very important!)
- Camera (optional)
- Sleeping bag & Pillow
- Warm Pajamas
- Slippers to wear inside the cabins
- MODEST swimsuit
Females: One piece Bathing
Males: Dark t-shirt and shorts
- Towel & washcloth
- Tennis shoes/closed toe shoes
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste)
- Insect repellent
- Sweatshirt or light jacket
- 5 days of modest clothing
- Good Attitude
- Willingness to learn

Things NOT to bring:

- Immodest clothing (see below)
- Body piercings: Please remove jewelry from all piercings.
(Females may wear earrings)
- Cell phones or electronic devices
(If brought, we'll hold during camp)
- Tattoos: Please cover all tattoos.
- Pets stay at home
- Alcohol, Tobacco, Vapes
- Illegal drugs, Marijuana
- Knives
- Lighters
- Fireworks
- Firearms

DRESS CODE:

Our dress code is aimed at making camp as distraction-free as possible. With that in mind, we ask everyone to abide by our current policy: We understand that within the Christian faith there are many opinions on appropriate styles and behaviors, and we do not want to be legalistic. We also do not want to offend others or cause CEF young people to focus on behaviors their parents would not agree with.

- No immodest clothing - no midriff showing, no short shorts (should reach fingertips when arms are hanging), no holes in clothing, no low necklines (cleavage showing), or bra straps showing.
- There are many variations of skinny pants (spandex, leggings, yoga pants, jeggings). Skinny pants must be covered by a top or skirt that reaches mid-thigh.
- Students should dress neatly in clothes that are not ripped or ragged.
